



2017 4-H/FFA Livestock Project Premium Program Guidelines

Participants must follow a feeding program using MFA feed products at recommended amounts. Suggested products include:

- Beef** - Cattle Charge, TrendSetter, Full Throttle, Ring Leader Show Ration, Super Beef 40, Super Beef 55-30, Steer Supplement 32, Beef Supplement 40, Natural 36, Cadence, Blu Ribbon Sweet feed, Heifer Show Ration and other complete MFA beef feeds
- Dairy** - 22-20 Milk Replacer, AAA Milk Replacer, Cow's Match Milk Replacer, Stand Out Dairy Calf Starter, Cattle Charge, TrendSetter, Turbo, Heartland and Super Cow
- Swine** - Evolution and RALCO ShowMax feeds
- Lamb** - Show Lamb, Sheep Supplement 34, Sheep Starter/Grower, and Sheep Charge
- Goat** - Superb Show Goat Ration, Goat Ration

Animals must be on MFA Feed from weigh-in and it must be fed through project completion.

Initial weight, ending weight and the other information requested on the Enrollment and Results form must be completed and verified by the group leader. For market animals, the weight at weigh-in is the initial weight.

Participants should complete the Enrollment and Results form and have the MFA retail manager sign it and submit it to MFA Feed Division. MFA retail locations will pay participants for project premiums and county rate-of-gain contest cash earned. MFA Feed Division will verify Missouri State Fair on-the-rail contest winners and prizes will be awarded at the fair. One project premium and one contest cash prize is allowed per participant.
